A First look inside Dovestone Gardens

We have shared CGI footage for the first time of inside Dovestone Gardens. The images show an insight into the facilities that will be available onsite including a bistro open to the public.

The 4-storey building has 71 x 2 bed apartments and 22 x 1 bed apartments and will have 50 car parking spaces with a mixture of resident and short stay visitor parking.

The CGI footage has been developed by freelance 3D artist Sam Calvert and the interior design work of Dovestone Gardens has been carried out by Studio Henderson who have worked on development projects across the North West. Dovestone Gardens has been designed by architects, Brock Carmichael.

Ring Stones praised for standard of work

Ring Stones have been praised for the standard of ethical work being carried out on Dovestone Gardens by the industry's independent assessor.

Ring Stones' work has been rated 'excellent' by the Considerate Constructors Scheme which is aimed at raising standards within the construction industry to build trust with the public in construction activity.

Ring Stones received full marks in the categories of respecting the community and valuing the workforce for work. The assessor singled out examples of good practice including customer engagement sessions, local school visits, 96.83% of total waste from the site has been recycled and a total of 2149 apprentice hours have been carried out on site so far.

What we are doing with your Feedback


We are constantly reviewing and re-looking at the way we engage with you
