Universal Credit Checklist

Here's our Universal Credit checklist to help you make a claim.

It is important that you have as much information as possible to hand when making a claim for Universal Credit.

□ Your email address and telephone number.

□ Your National Insurance Number, if you do not have your National Insurance card, you may be able to find this on a payslip, letter from HMRC or a letter from the DWP.

□ Proof of your identity, such as your passport, driving licence or EEA national identity card. If you don't have photo ID, please inform the Job Centre.

 $\hfill\square$ Proof of your address, including post code, such as an official letter from a bank or utility bill.

□ Details of your bank, building society or credit union account, including its name, sort code and account number. If you don't have an account, you will need to open one.

 $\hfill\square$ The type of accommodation you live in, for example, housing association tenancy and a copy of your tenancy agreement.

- $\hfill\square$ Your landlord's name and address.
- \Box How much you pay in weekly rent.
- □ If applicable, how many `rent free weeks' you receive.
- □ If you are employed, details of how much you earn from work.

 $\hfill\square$ Details of any income that's not from work, for example from a pension or child maintenance payments.

- □ Details of any savings you have.
- □ Details of any other benefits you are receiving.
